

The tender documents along with CDR/FDR equal to 2% of quoted rates should reach the office of Joint Commissioner (W) Town Hall Building, Jammu Municipal Corporation Jammu - 180001 on or before 17th January up to 2 p.m. through registered/ Speed Post only and will be opened on the same day or any other convenient day in the office of Commissioner JMC Jammu. The Chairman Central Purchase Committee, Jammu Municipal Corporation reserves the right to accept or reject any tender with out assigning any reason there of.

Other detailed terms and conditions are contained in detailed NIT, copy of which can be had from Single window of JMC or from the Office of the Executive Engineer (E) JMC against a payment of Rs 500/- as cost of tender document.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

1. The successful tenderer shall have to draw an agreement with the department soon after the allotment of the contract is made in their favour.
2. **Payment**
 - i) 90% payment shall be made by the department against each consignment delivered, inspected, accepted and properly surveyed and material brought on stock in the concerned stock register of the department No advance payment shall be made.
 - ii) 10% balance payment shall be made by the department after one year, after checking the performance of the material supplied.
3. Remittance charges (Bank Commission) on payment made to the firm will be borne by the supplier.
4. As soon as the acceptance of the tender is communicated to the successful tenderer the contract shall be completely binding on him. The formal deed in incorporating the terms and conditions shall be executed by the successful tenderer lateron. Failure to the execute such a bond/ deed shall not however prevent the contract for being enforced against him. Any loss sustained by the corporation as a result of retendering the contract shall be recovered form the defaulter.
5. All legal proceedings arising out of any dispute between the parties shall be within the jurisdiction of the Commissioner, JMC whose decision shall be final and binding.
6. The successful tenderer shall arrange supplies within the period mentioned in the supply order the period of delivery and validity can however be extended if

- mutually agreed to within the currency of the contract, provided sufficient reason/ justification are given by the supplier in such individual cases.
7. The contract / order can be repudiated any time if the supplies are not made according to satisfaction of department.
 8. The tenderer should sign every page of the tender.
 9. The tenderer shall be responsible for proper packing of the supplies so as to avoid damage under normal transport and delivery of the material in the good condition to the consignee. In case of any loss, damage, breakage, the tenderer shall be liable to make good the loss and shortage found at the time of checking/ inspections of material by the consignee. No cost on such account shall be admissible.
 10. If the successful tenderer fails to supply the goods of the prescribed specifications or fails to deliver the goods within the stipulated time as specially mentioned in the supply order, department shall be at liberty to arrange supplies, otherwise the department may give 15 days notice to the approved supplier in writing to make good the supplies. The amount of the earnest money deposited by the supplier will be utilized to make good the loss sustained or excess cost incurred by the corporation in arranging of the supplies and other remedies that may be available to the corporation under the law for the time being in force in the state.
 11. The supplier shall not sublet the contract or any part thereof to any other agency.
 12. The quality of the material should confirm to approved sample and specification in the supply order.
 13. The Chairman Central Purchase Committee Jammu Municipal Corporation reserves the right to reject any tender without any assigning reason thereof.
 14. The quantity of 1500 Nos. G.I. Brackets as per annexure is tentative and are required for the full financial year 2011-12. The quantities can vary up to $\pm 25\%$ and the quantities will be ordered and lifted as per requirement.
 15. Delay in supply will invite penalty up to 10%.
 16. For each supply, Separate tender and CDR shall be accepted in separate envelope. Such offers which are clubbed in one envelope will be rejected.
 17. The rates accepted shall remain in force for the complete financial year 2011-12 and suppliers shall be bound to supply the required material within prescribed time after the receipt of supply order from XEN (E).
